

Year 6 Transition Activities

Overview

<u>Term 1-</u> **The Normans**: We will study how the Normans changed England. In 1066 William the Conqueror arrived from France and won a major battle. This unit will cover the battle, the Norman Conquest of England and how Britain changed because of it.

<u>Term 2-</u> Medieval Kings: this unit will look at how the power of kings gradually changed during the medieval period. They used to be all powerful and could do whatever they wanted but slowly the government and parliament started to take that power away from them, we will study this.

<u>Term 3-</u> **Religious Rollercoaster**: this unit will look at how religion changed during the Tudor period in England. Henry VIII and his three children were all monarchs and each one affected the religion of the country, making it protestant or catholic. This led to wars, plots, burning people at the stake, nasty nicknames and even nursery rhymes. You will study the Tudor family and their impact on Britain.


Task 1
