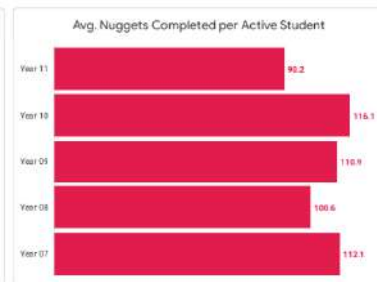
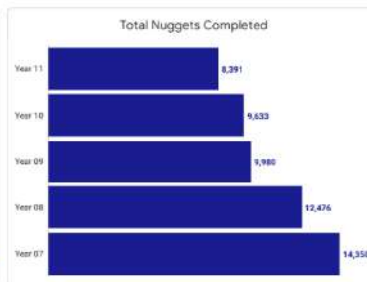
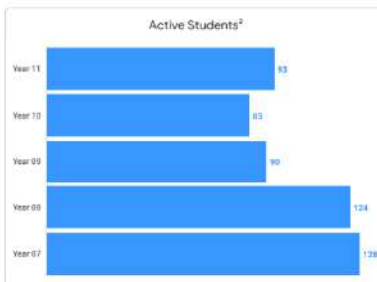

### Century Tech

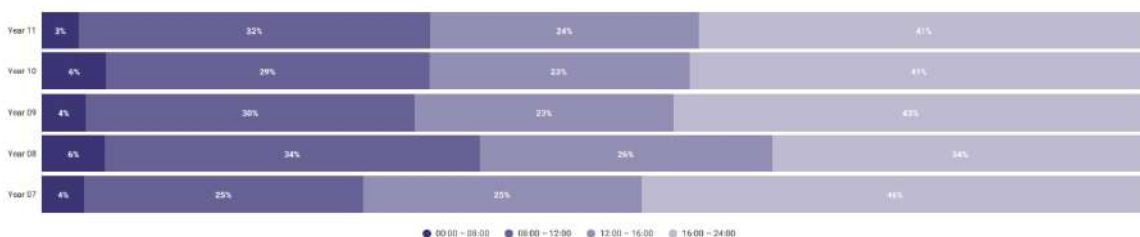
