Headteacher Update:

Dear Parents & Carers

We have had another really productive week at Great Wyrley Academy. Despite the bitterly cold weather this week students have shown some real resilience and determination in lessons in particular.

Our assembly and form time theme this week has been focused on “*respect*”. We have discussed the importance of Respect which is a fundamental cornerstone in creating a positive and productive learning environment within a school. We have discussed how respect goes beyond politeness; it is a deep appreciation for the diverse perspectives and backgrounds of both students and teachers. When individuals in a school community treat one another with respect, it fosters a sense of belonging and inclusivity. Students are more likely to engage in their lessons when they feel valued and respected by their teachers and fellow students. Students have responded to this well and the number of students who have demonstrated being respectful in and out of the classroom and been awarded Aspire points for this has tripled this week so a huge well done to all those students.

I would like to discuss how we further demonstrate our Aspire values, in particular being respectful once we leave the school gates. Sadly, we have seen an increase in the number of incidents that have been reported to the school long after the school day has ended. This includes instances of anti-social behaviour and physical aggression. I will not tolerate this type of behaviour, bringing the school into disrepute will be dealt with using the highest sanction possible. Students are aware of how to behave outside of school and I encourage Parents and Carers to discuss this with them at home to reinforce this message. I would also strongly encourage you to keep talking to us if you have any concerns about our students' behaviour outside of school hours. We will continue to educate our students on this matter through our form time activities and Aspire for Life days. I also need to stress that this is limited to a small number of students and I want to thank all of those students that conduct themselves in an orderly and professional manner every single day.

Attendance overall has remained stable this week but, for Year groups 8 - 11 this has been at the lowest point since the start of the academic year. A huge congratulations to Year 7 students and families who have had the best attendance to school this week with a weekly attendance figure of 97%. This is an incredible achievement. I will continue to stress every week how attendance to school has a direct impact on the progress that students make in lessons and how absence from school can have a negative impact on how students socialise and maintain friendship groups. You will be well aware that all school information related to attendance including the NHS guidance on whether or not your child is too ill to come to school can be found on our school website [here](#).

We have seen an increase over the last few weeks in those absences that are unauthorised in particular those where no reason for the absence is given. It is essential that on the first day of

absence you provide a reason, if we do not have a reason for the absence, as part of our safeguarding procedures, we will conduct a home visit the same day. I would really appreciate your support in ensuring that you contact school if your child is unable to attend school whether this be via parentmail, study bugs or simply contacting the main reception.

As always if you have any concerns around your child's attendance please make sure that you contact the school who will be happy to support however we can.

I will leave you now to read through the rest of the bulletin. I hope you have a lovely weekend.

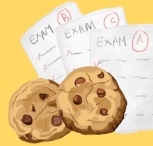

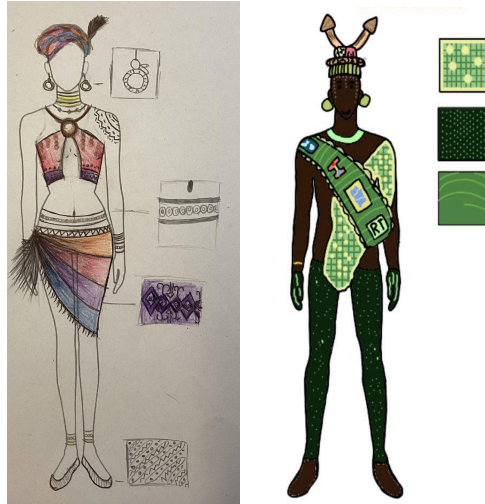
Year 7 Food Superstars

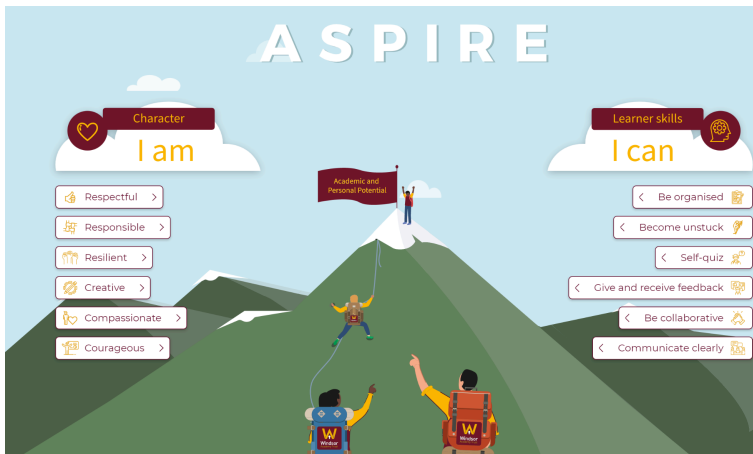
The passwords for students to be able to access the work experience support services database will be given out in form time next week. There is a link to the database in the Year 10 Google Classroom for them to be able to access it.
