Dear Parents & Carers

If in the very rare instance we have to shut the school for any reason, the following actions would take place:-

- A text message will be sent to all families as early as possible to inform you of a school closure
- If this is during the day and you are unable to collect your child or allow them to go home independently, we will remain on site with them until the end of the day.
- A notification will go onto our website and our social media pages.
- Any work set that day will be done through google classrooms for pupils to complete.

We will monitor the situation carefully throughout that day and as soon as we can confirm we are reopening or perhaps need to remain shut, we will communicate with you again via the methods above. I must stress that this will be in very rare and extreme circumstances and I will always endeavour to remain open as you know I have done previously but, as we have had so many queries I wanted to make sure that it was clear to everyone what would happen.

I will leave you to read through the rest of the bulletin for this week and remind you again that we are closed on Friday 8th December as per the calendar for staff INSET. I hope you have a lovely weekend.

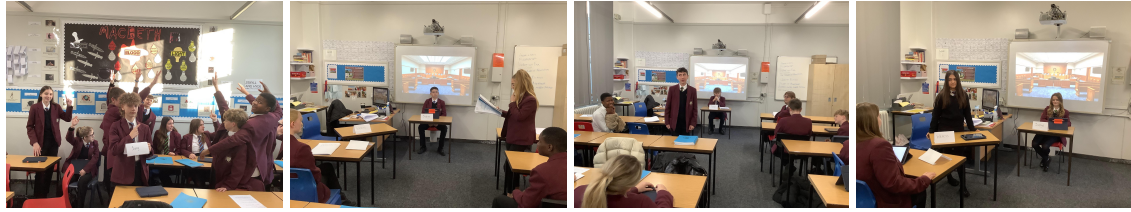

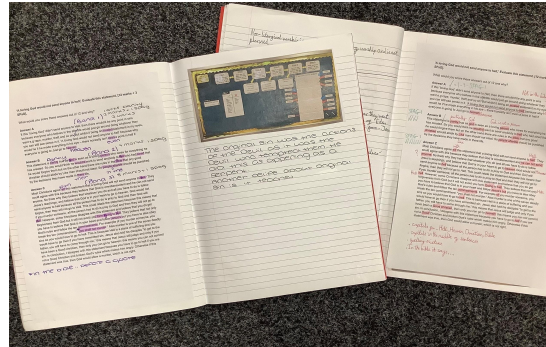
Special shoutout to Lacey Maycock who planned to a very fine detail and made the courtroom seem very realistic.

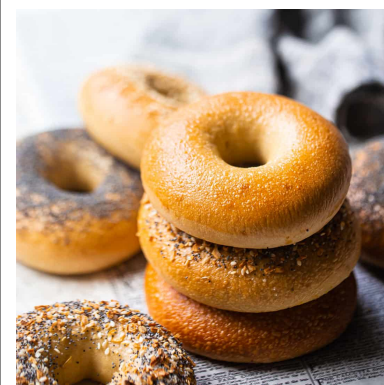
