You will know from my communications with you that the start of terms and half terms are my favourite times in the year as it gives everyone a real chance to refresh, reflect and start again. This is also the point at which I like to reinforce our high standards and expectations and provide clarity on other areas and I thought that I would use this bulletin to share those with you.

#### **Attendance:**

Attendance at school is crucial, there is a direct link between attendance and progress made. Regular attendance to school also has an impact on students' abilities to form and maintain friendships and other social skills.

We understand that determining whether or not to send your child to school when they are unwell can be a challenging decision. Therefore, we want to provide you with recently updated NHS guidance about common illnesses which will hopefully be useful.

We have a very experienced pastoral team who are able to support you with any difficulties or questions you may have around your child's attendance and I would encourage you to contact school and speak to your child's form tutor in the first instance. On a positive note, when we do return to school we will be launching our whole school "attendance opoly game". Further details to follow.

#### **Uniform:**

Our rules around uniform have remained the same all year. Hoodies and trainers are not allowed. If there is an issue with footwear we have ample pairs of shoes that can be borrowed until the issue is rectified. Notes are not acceptable and can only be accepted if they are from a medical professional. Uniform largely at Great Wyrley is impeccable however, skirts in particular are becoming an issue and I want to make sure that the guidance on skirts is clear. Black skirts must be worn of styles indicated below and again no stretchy, clingy fabrics will be allowed. Tube style skirts will not be permitted. Skirts must be knee length. #### PE Kit:

Mr Phillips, our Curriculum Lead for PE, wrote to you last week to discuss the rules around our PE kit. A summary of those expectations can be found below

As the year has gone on, there has been a dip in some of the standards and consistency across the Academy with regards to kit for PE lessons. PE kit, like the Academy uniform, is an expectation for all students. The Great Wyrley PE kit is worn during lessons for hygiene reasons and also to ensure all students are conforming to high standards and expectations of appropriate kit. Below are a few expectations that will be enforced as of Monday 8th April.

#### Year 7-9 students:

- All students MUST bring a GWA kit for PE lessons This is the black collared PE top with the Great Wyrley badge on.
- The GWA top and/or GWA hoodie can be worn with GWA shorts, GWA Skorts, Black Football shorts or black leggins Cycling shorts are not permitted.
- All students must bring appropriate trainers for completing physical activity school shoes and Crocs/sandals are not permitted.

#### Year 10 Students:

- All students MUST bring a minimum of a GWA top to PE lessons
- The GWA top can be worn with plain black jumpers/jackets black shorts and black leggins.

#### **Year 10 BTEC Sport and Dance students:**

ALL Sport and Dance students should be arriving to practical lessons with the correct GWA PE kit. As we progress through the course there will be a lot of recording during practical lessons and the standard of the kit must be high for everyone. As BTEC students they are the elite standard for PE and role models for the KS3 students.

#### iPad:

All students have access to an iPad to use in and out of school. It is important that students see this as essential pieces of equipment and bring it to school, fully charged every single day just as they would bring a pen with them. Without this students will be unable to access learning materials in the majority of their lessons and so it will hinder their impact greatly. If students have any iPad issues at all they must make sure that they report them to their form tutor who can refer it to their Head of Year.

#### **Conduct outside of school:**

Whilst we have high expectations around student behaviour in school that does not stop once they leave the school gate. I wrote to you earlier on in the term to discuss the importance of modelling our school values and being a responsible citizen especially whilst wearing our school uniform. Students are reminded about the impact anti social behaviour can have on the community and if any such incidents are reported to the school we will investigate and sanction accordingly.

#### School site access and parking:

It is important that I remind you again of our policy for on-site parking. It is not permitted for you to park in the school grounds. In addition, we ask you to please consider the safety of the staff and students by not driving onto the school site if the gates are open. Parking is also not-permitted on Hall lane where double yellow lines are clearly marked. We have seen increased patrols by traffic wardens this year and this will continue to be the case next term. Additionally, if you wish to see a member of staff it must be via prior appointment which can be arranged by contacting the main reception.

Finally a reminder to all Year 11 parents that we will be running Easter school during the school holidays. We have sent the timetable via parent mail with some guidance around session timings. We look forward to as many students as possible attending so that we can use the time to plug those remaining knowledge gaps in preparation for the summer exams.

I will leave you now to read through the rest of the bulletin. I want to thank you for your continued support and I wish you all a restful Easter break.
