#### **Headteacher Update:**

**Dear Parents & Carers** 

Another productive week has passed at Great Wyrley Academy. Once again, we have seen a record number of Aspire points being awarded, we have seen a reduction in negative behaviour points and an increase in school attendance and we hope to see this continue over the rest of the term.

Year 11 commenced their mock exams this week. Many of the students have approached the exams positively and with real resilience. It is essential that during this period of time students are also looking after their well being. Students should ensure that they are getting plenty of sleep the night before and that they get a good breakfast in the morning. We will be providing breakfast every morning from Tuesday 28th November for all of Year 11 for the rest of their mock exams during form time to help support this. Attendance during this mock exam period is absolutely essential, if students are absent for any reason please inform the attendance office immediately. We wish Year 11 the best of luck and look forward to seeing the results of their hard work.

I'm afraid that this week I need to remind all parents and carers that are travelling by car that parking up on the school site is not allowed. This is a matter of health and safety. We have seen an increase in the number of drop off and collections on school grounds. If you need to come onto the school site for any reason please park outside of the school gates unless this is for a pre-arranged meeting during the school day. This does not apply to those who require disabled access onto the site.

It is that time of year where we review and practise some of our health and safety procedures. At some point during this term we will practise our fire drills, evacuation plans and full lockdown drills. All of which are required by law and so we will be briefing the students over the next week on what these may look like. There could be a number of reasons as to why a school may need to go into lockdown such as having a dangerous dog on site or poisonous gases or smoke over the school site and it is important that we practise what we need to do as a school in each of these situations albeit rare situations.

#### **Preparedness for Assignments:**



#### Review and Re-do



We are now moving into the Review and Re-do phase of the 360 cycle. Students will be working on filling the knowledge gaps in their lessons for the next 2 weeks.

This will be done by one of the following methods:

#### R1. Re-draft/Re-do:

Students provided with the opportunity to enhance their work by revisiting and repeating it.

#### R2. Rehearse or Repeat:

Students to focus on specific aspects of their learning that they have previously encountered, aiming to bolster their confidence and fluency.

#### R3. Re-visit and Respond:


Students to revisit and reinforce their understanding by responding to additional, similar questions related to the material.

#### R4. Re-learn Material and Re-test:

Students gap in knowledge are identified and they are re-taught the content. Subsequently, assess their understanding through various means, such as exit tickets or Google forms.

#### R5. Research and Record:

Students improve their work by referencing a broader range of ideas, texts, case studies, examples, or incorporating more detailed information. Students conduct research and integrating these findings into an enhanced version of their task, leveraging available digital technology.
