# Parent Bulletin - Friday 6th October 2023

#### **Headteacher Update:**

Dear Parents & Carers

I write to you at the end of week 5, the summer seems like a past memory and half term still seems very far away. Students have felt the pinch this week as the nights get a little darker and the days a little colder. It is really important as we enter the middle of the Autumn term that we keep standards and expectations high with our particular focus at the moment on attendance to school. Despite the oncoming heatwave, I have had several queries around students bringing coats to school, just to confirm students can of course bring a coat to school. All that we ask is that these are not worn in the building as has always been the rule, this includes movement to and from lessons.

I wrote to you all earlier in the week with some further guidance around "Is my child too ill to go to school". This NHS guidance has been really helpful in guiding parents and carers to decide whether or not their child should remain off school especially, as we enter cold and flu season. A link to guidance we have sent out can be found <a href="here">here</a> as always if you have any concerns or queries it is important that you contact the main reception. Many of the conversations I have had with families this week have been around trying to build resilience and encouraging students to come to school when they are unwell but well enough to come into school. Students whose absence rate is 90% at the end of the academic year equals 19 days of absence throughout the school year. This lost learning will have a direct impact on the progress students are making in their subjects. If you are concerned at all about your child's attendance at school please contact the attendance team who will try and support you however we can to ensure your child has a positive attendance record.

On Thursday we had our first Aspire for Life Day where students attend lessons that are planned around our PSHE curriculum. Students in all Year groups covered topics such as mental health, health and well being and drugs and alcohol, more details of this are in the curriculum section. Students were well engaged and participated in some really healthy debates and conversations around what were some very sensitive topics and we are really proud that students have taken such an active approach in developing their personal growth and development in these areas.

I will leave you to read through the rest of the bulletin. I hope you have a lovely weekend.

#### School Events for this week:

This is the first time we have held this event and are very excited to have students from the 5 secondary schools across the trust joining us for what will be a fantastic day of competitive girls football. We look forward to reporting the results next Friday.



**French:** On the 3rd October the Paris Trip 2024 was launched for year 9 and year 10. After a successful trip last year we have decided to run the trip again but add an extra day on, so pupils can have as much time in Paris as possible, soaking up the culture and seeing monuments.

**ADT:** After school clubs in Art, Design and Technology have had a brilliant uptake so far this year. A new club for this year is the Set Design Club and their first commission has been to turn the Library into an Alice in Wonderland experience. They have started work on creating roses this week.



**History:** All parents and students taking part in the WW1 Battlefields Tour 2023 were invited to a presentation evening, during which Mrs Broad Wood shared with everyone the sites to be visited during the trip as well as the terribly early departure time of 2:30am. We have ordered a poppy wreath to be placed at the Menin Gate by representatives of the school when we attend the evening ceremony on 27th October.

GCSE Y11 students have been working hard over the last week to complete their first key assessment task focused upon the current unit of Conflict and

Cooperation 1919-1939. The topic assessed was primarily linked to the work of the peacemakers and the League of Nations, Tamzin Booth and M'Ballou Kallon's responses particularly stood out and were used as WAGOLLS with their peers.

**RE:** The students have demonstrated excellent communication skills when exploring such topics as:

- Does God exist?
- Can he be all loving if there is evil in the world?
- How did the world begin?
- Are humans the pinnacle of creation?

#### Philosophical question of the week:

**English:** In English Year 7 have now successfully completed their standardised reading tests and intervention where applicable will be organised! Fantastic achievement has been demonstrated across the board and relentless resilience was shown! Great work Year 7!

**ADT:** We have been working on Mandala Design and using organic shapes in Year 7 Art. The students have created some beautiful Mandalas and observations of shells. Some of the work produced is absolutely phenomenal - stunning use of shape, tone and texture. Well done Year 7.
