Dear Parents & Carers

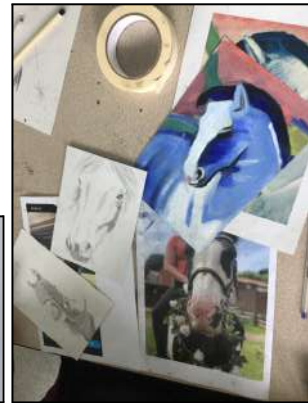


### **PE and Sport:**

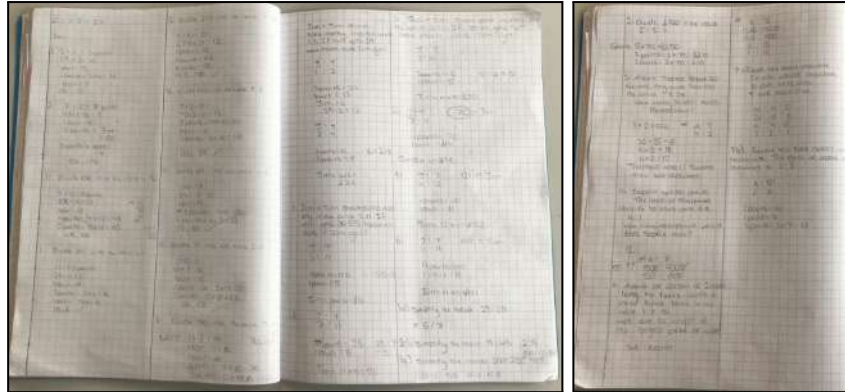
### **English:**

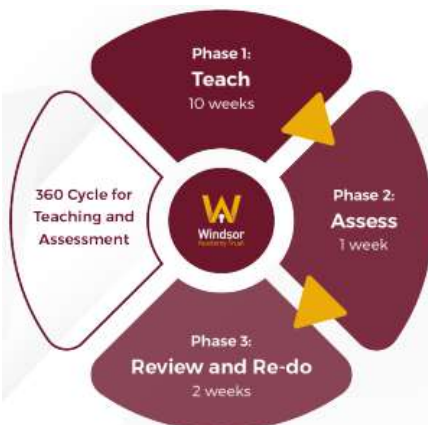
