DAY TRIPS

Monday 17 July 2023 Weston Super Mare Trip – Students will be leaving school at 8:00am

traffic.

Wednesday 19 July 2023 Go Ape Trip - Students will be leaving school at 9:30am prompt and

returning from Go Ape at 2:30pm. Arrival back at school is estimated to

be between 3:00pm and 3:30pm.

Students on trips will need to bring packed lunches and snacks(unless they are in receipt of this from the school canteen normally, then this will be provided for all three trips), wear the appropriate active clothing for the weather conditions, sun cream, sun hat and plenty to drink. A small amount of money can be taken; it will be students responsibility to keep this safe. For the beach activities we suggest students may want to bring a picnic blanket and/or a beach towel to sit on, and any beach/ball games they may have. Students must understand that anything they bring is their responsibility to look after.

IN SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

For students who are not on trips we will be running activities throughout the week in school, there will be no charge for these.

- Students will be expected to attend from 10:00am until 2:30pm on Monday to Thursday and 10:00am until 12:45pm on Friday. Students are to meet in their year group designated areas each morning to register, details will follow on google classrooms for specific roomings.
